

**SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 505, 2006**

Being a By-Law to provide Director's Remuneration

WHEREAS the Board deems it advisable to provide remuneration for Directors and to repeal Bylaw No. 491, 2006 and amendment thereto:

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid out of annual revenue, remuneration as follows:
 - a) The sum of seven thousand two hundred and seventeen (\$7,878.00) dollars per annum to Directors representing the City of Prince Rupert, District of Port Edward, Village Masset, Village of Queen Charlotte, Village of Port Clements, Electoral Areas "A", "C", "D" and "E".

2. In addition to the Director's remuneration in 1 above there shall be paid:
 - a) to the Chair of the Board the sum of five thousand five hundred and fifty eight (\$5,891.00) dollars per annum;
 - b) to the Vice Chair of the Board the sum of fifteen hundred and sixty (\$1,560) dollars per annum;
 - c) to all members of the Board one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars for attendance at each regular and special meeting of the Board of Directors; and
 - d) one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars per meeting attended for Alternate Directors from all areas.

3. In the event that the Chair becomes incapacitated due to illness, the Vice Chair will assume the role of the Chair and will be compensated at the Chair's remuneration as identified in 1 above.

4. Bylaw No. 491-2006 is hereby repealed.

5. This Bylaw is effective January 1, 2007.

6. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Director's Remuneration Bylaw No. 505, 2006".
