

SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 518-2008

Being a Bylaw to Establish a Water Service in a Portion of Electoral Area "A" – Dodge Cove.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 800(1) of the *Local Government Act*, a Board must first adopt an establishing bylaw in order to operate a service;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to operate a water service in a portion of Electoral Area "A" – Dodge Cove;

AND WHEREAS the electors of Dodge Cove have provided evidence of their support for the operation of a water service by the Board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. **CITATION**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District Dodge Cove Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 518-2008".

2. **SERVICE BEING ESTABLISHED**

The service being established under the authority of this Bylaw is the service of the provision, distribution and treatment of water.

3. **SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES**

The Boundaries of the service area are a portion of Electoral Area "A" – Dodge Cove shown outlined in Schedule "A" of this Bylaw. The service area shall be known as the "Dodge Cove Water System Service Area".

4. **PARTICIPATING AREA**

Electoral Area "A" – Dodge Cove is the only participating area of this service.

5. **METHOD OF COST RECOVERY**

The annual cost of providing this service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:

- (a) by the imposition of a parcel tax imposed under section 803.(1) of the *Local Government Act*; and
- (b) by the imposition of fees and other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw.

6. MAXIMUM REQUISITION

The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned annually in support of this service shall not exceed Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).
