

**SKEENA-QUEEN CHARLOTTE REGIONAL DISTRICT  
BYLAW NO. 451, 2004**

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Being a bylaw to amend Bylaw 322 the rates, terms and conditions under which Waste Management Services may be supplied in the Mainland Solid Waste Service Area

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**WHEREAS** the Board has adopted a Regional Solid Waste Management Plan;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has adopted the Mainland Solid Waste Management Local Service Bylaw 270;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 1 of Bylaw 270, 1994 authorizes the Board to regulate the collection, storage, and removal of solid waste and recyclable material;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 4 of Bylaw 270, 1994 authorizes the levying of user fees and other charges;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed advisable to rescind Bylaw 322, 1996 and certain portions of Bylaw 270 and amendments thereof;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of the Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

**SECTION ONE: COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLES**

1. A recyclable collection service will be provided to accessible commercial and institutional location in Prince Rupert and Port Edward on a fee for service basis.
2. The terms & conditions of this service will be set from time to time by the Mainland Solid Waste Management Committee.
3. Fees for service are described in Schedule 1.

**SECTION TWO: DROP-OFF FACILITIES**

1. Public Drop-off Facilities will be established and maintained in Prince Rupert and Port Edward.
2. A public drop-off area will be operated and maintained at the recycling depot.
3. Operating hours, materials accepted and other terms and conditions of use will be set from time to time by the Mainland Solid Waste Management Committee.
4. Fees for service are described in Schedule 2.

**SECTION THREE: RECYCLING DEPOT - STORAGE & MANAGEMENT OF RECYCLABLES**

1. A recycling depot will be operated and maintained as an Envirocentre as described in the Regional Solid Waste Management Plan.
2. Policies concerning operation hours, materials accepted, storage and other conditions of use will be set from time to time by the Mainland Solid Waste Management Committee.
3. Where applicable, recycling programs and initiatives will be coordinated with existing provincial programs and policies.
4. Fees for service are described in Schedule 3.

**SECTION FOUR: TITLE**

1. This By-Law may be cited as the *"Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District Mainland Solid Waste Management Regulation, fees, and charges By-Law No.451, 2004"*.

**SCHEDULE ONE: COMMERCIAL RECYCLING COLLECTION FEES**

1. Collection may be provided on regular or on call basis.
2. Customers will be billed monthly or quarterly.
3. The following fees apply:

<b><u>Service</u></b>	<b><u>Cost Per Pick-up</u></b>
Office paper collection	\$8.00
Battery pick-up	\$12.00
Cardboard collection (on regular collection route)	\$13.00
Cardboard Collection (on special collection requiring entire truck)	\$30.00
Tire pick-up	\$12.00
Special Services (required in addition to pick-up)	\$24.00/hr.

## **SCHEDULE TWO: DROP-OFF FEES AND SERVICES**

1. No fees will apply to unstaffed facilities.
2. Unless specified below, no fees will be assessed for recyclable materials dropped off.

<b><u>Material</u></b>	<b><u>Fee</u></b>
<i>Appliance without CFC's (ie: stove, hot water tank, dishwasher, washer, dryer, furnace etc.)</i>	<i>\$9.00</i>
<i>Other bulky objects (accepted at discretion of manager)</i>	<i>\$ 9.00 +5¢/kg over 180kg</i>
<i>Appliance with CFC's (fridge, freezer, airconditioner)</i>	<i>\$20.00</i>
<i>Large (16"-22" radius) tires</i>	<i>\$8.00</i>
<i>Garbage (incidental to dropped off recyclables)</i>	<i>\$2.00/bag or \$.10/kg</i>
	<i>Applicable taxes apply.</i>

**SCHEDULE THREE: RECYCLING DEPOT - STORAGE  
MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

1. From time to time surplus space may be available. This space may be rented with preference given according to:
  - 1) another service operated by the Regional District;
  - 2) services operated by member municipalities;
  - 3) non-profit organizations; and
  - 4) other.
  
2. The following rates will apply:
  - a) Office space = fair market value
  - b) Inside storage/warehouse space = fair market value
  - c) Outside vehicle/camper/boat storage:  
\$30/month for first 6 metres plus \$0.50/m for additional space or  
\$7.00/day
